SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, this isn't for debate purposes but 782 is the bill. There's no fiscal impact statement in the book. I just wondered if there is one or.... There is no impact.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to return. I think he can make that inquiry later. Would you record your presence Senator Clark and Senator Cavanaugh. Alright. Roll call vote. Oh wait, there was a request that the amendment be read before the roll call commences.

CLERK: The motion I have is to amend 432 by putting provisions of 782 into the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas, for what purpose do you ask recognition?

SENATOR SYAS: I want to ask a question before the vote.

PRESIDENT: Yes sir.

SENATOR SYAS: Now if this goes on the amendment ... this amendment goes on, what happens to the bill that's in Committee on this same thing? Will that be....

PRESIDENT: That matter was debated to a limited extent between Senator Chambers and Senator DeCamp. If this motion is successful it will be debated further when there's debate on the motion itself.

Senator Lewis, for what purpose do you ask recognition?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I'd like that motion read again.

PRESIDENT: Alright. All Senators please stay in your chairs. Senator Duis, for what purpose do you ask recognition?

SENATOR DUIS: Question of the Chair if I might.

PRESIDENT: Yes sir.

SENATOR DUIS: Is this a proper amendment by merely stating the contents of the Legislative Bill as an amendment?

PRESIDENT: That would be a legitimate question to ask when the matter is under debate. The matter is now shall the bill be returned. Alright, now read the amendment once more please. Please read the amendment, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: It reads as follows: To amend 432 by putting provisions of 782 in the bill.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote.

CLERK: Senator Anderson--

President, It's roll call, I'm sorry.
