CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Education, to whom was referred LB 631, instructs me to report the same to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File as amended.

Mr. President, there will be an Attorney General's opinion inserted in the Journal, addressed to Senator Frank Lewis, number 180.

Mr. President, I move for the introduction of the attached bill. Signed, Senator Warner. It's a bill dealing with cities and villages with respect to public power.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, this bill was brought to me by the City of Lincoln. You will notice by the sheet that was passed out that it re-enacts two sections of a bill, LB 104, that was passed last session. There was some concern on the part of bond attorneys which we are accustomed to hearing that the title was not quite ... may have been faulty in 104 when it was passed relative to two sections of the bill. Those two sections are repeated in identical wording. There is an additional provision in the act which indicates that a municipality could cooperate in the ownership of a generation or transmission line if that generation plant is located outside of the State of Nebraska.

I visited with the Chairman of the Public Works Committee who indicated that.... I do believe that it should have a proper hearing. Indicated perhaps we could hold one next week over a noon hour so that we would, in no way, adversely affect the deliberations of this body. I'd ask that the bill would be introduced.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is the introduction of the bill. Record your vote. Please vote. Please vote. We need two more. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, Mr. President, no nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The bill shall be introduced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Read title to LB 1005.

Mr. President, LR 121 calls for a study by the Judiciary Committee during the interim on the matter of administrative rules. That should properly be referred to the Executive Board.

That's all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We move to General File. We'll commence with LB 313.
