SENATOR MARVEL: OK. The last one he read was simply a change in agency number, from 13 to 12. So I guess we've got to OK that first. I move the adoption of the amendment to the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of the amendment to the amendment. Please vote. Savage voting aye. Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes on motion to adopt the amendment to the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment to the amendment has been adopted.

SENATOR MARVEL: Mr. President, I move that the amendment, as amended, be adopted.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the amendment ... the Committee amendments as adopted. Is there any further discussion? Please vote.

CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The Committee amendments have been adopted.

SENATOR MARVEL: Now I move that 684, as amended, be advanced to E & R initial.

CLERK: Alright, Mr. President, Senator Frank Lewis asks unanimous consent to withdraw an amendment to LB 684, found on page I don't have a page, but it's found in the Journal ... 737.

PRESIDENT: You're asking unanimous consent, Senator Lewis? Senator Lewis?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Yes, I am.

PRESIDENT: Alright, is there any objection? Hearing none, it's so ordered. Question now is to adopt ... is to advance LB 684 to E & R initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed the opposite.

CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, 22 not voting.

PRESIDENT: At this time I'd like to notify you that there were 30 ladies from the Holy Family Church from Omaha, Father McKaslan's church, were in the balcony. I didn't want to interrupt debate, but I do want to recognize that they were here this morning. They're from Senator Chambers' district.
