SENATOR RASMUSSEN: Mr. President, members of the body, I think probably half of us on this floor take a out of state trip and, probably, I know at least fish and, perhaps, hunt, too, and I, for one, and I think every Senator on the floor, we do not write and ask what the license fee is going to be because we go anyway. As far as the spin off, you are right. It does cost. I know the turkey we got this fall up at Fort Robinson was quite expensive per pound but I assure you that the license fee didn't enter in. It was the spin off. I still say, regardless if we raise these fees or not, the people will come. We will still receive the spin off and I think that the state is entitled to a higher fee from the out of state people and I would ask for your support in adopting my amendment.
