Mr. President, Senator Mills asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 491 in the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Any objections? So ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Marvel gives notice of an Executive Committee meeting of the Appropriations Committee at noon in Room 1003.

Mr. President, I move we recess till 1:30. Signed, Senator Burbach.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to recess till 1:30. All those in favor say aye, opposed nay. Carried.

SPEAKER: The Legislature will please come to order. Please record your presence. Have you all voted? Please record your presence. Clerk will record.

CLERK: Quorum present.

Mr. President, when we quit at noon there was pending before the Legislature LB 665. On Select File. Mr. President, it was advanced to E & R initial. Correction, it was advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossing. It was returned for a Koch specific amendment. There are then attempts to amend the specific amendment which cannot be done. The only thing pending, Mr. President, is the Koch amendment.

SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, would the Clerk.... What's the situation with 665 right now?

CLERK: The only thing pending on it is your specific amendment for which the bill was returned from E & R for engrossing to Select File to consider your specific amendment, which is in the Journal, page 904.

SENATOR KOCH: The bill is on Select File, though, isn't it.

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR KOCH: I thought you said it was on E & R engrossing. I thought maybe it was another 673 or something. If they ran it across there in a hurry, I didn't know about it, that was what bothered me.

CLERK: We do a lot of things in a hurry.

SENATOR KOCH: At any rate the introducer is amenable to....

CLERK: You cannot amend it.
