SENATOR CAVANAUGH: You want me to close again now?

PRESIDENT: Well, if there was anything in those concluding remarks that you feel need reply, you may reply. Otherwise, we don't need a close. All right. You have heard the motion. Record your vote. Please vote.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I will ask for a Call of the House and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: All right. The question is...will you clear the Board, Mr. Clerk. Clear the Board, please. The question is...clear the Board, please...shall the House go under Call? Please vote. The question is, shall the House go under Call? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 14 nays.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. Please return to your desks, Senators, and record your presence. There has been a request for a roll call vote. Record your presence, please. Senator Fitzgerald, would you record your presence, please. Senator Lewis.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Could I ask how many are excused?

PRESIDENT: How many are excused? There were seven this morning. How many are excused, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Three.

PRESIDENT: Three. Would the Senators please take your desks so we can make sure that everyone is here to commence the roll. Senator Anderson, would you record your presence. There has been a request to read the amendment once more, Mr. Clerk. Would you kindly read it.

CLERK: Read amendment. See page 997, Journal.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Will the Sergeant at Arms find the other people, Senator Chambers and....

PRESIDENT: If the Senators will stay at their desks, we will attempt to find the other members. What members are missing, please?

CLERK: Keyes, Chambers.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner, Senator Chambers and who else? Senator Chambers is here and Senator Kelly is here. Senator Warner is the only one missing. Senator Warner. Commence the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote. See page 1020, Journal. 18 ayes, 27 nays, remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Senator Savage moves that the Call be raised. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The Call is raised. The motion fails.
