PRESIDENT: The motion fails.

CLERK: That is the next one up. Mr. President there are several amendments to 861 but the bill was returned for E & R amendments and that is really all that can be adopted. We will have to advance the bill then and then return it.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President I move that LB861 be advanced for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All those in favor say aye....

CLERK: Wait a minute, we have to adopt the E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: OK.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. They are adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB861 be advanced for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All those in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Alright Mr. President, the first motion is I move to return LB861 to Select File for specific amendment. On page 3, line 23, insert "game birds" after the word "any", and before the word "upland". Signed Senator Dworak.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, this is something that should have been caught in Enrollment and Review, it is the deletion of one word. We define game birds and upland game birds and it wasn't put in this section of the bill and it should be put in. I request that we return the bill to correct this.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? Question is shall the bill be returned for the specific amendment. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion prevails.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion of Senator Dworak's amendment. Question is its adoption. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays and 22 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move that LB861 be advanced to E & R Engrossment.
