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have given you, I guess that particular information is not in your files.

SENATOR DWORAK: As we go through this whole budget procedure, the only figures we have are the new figures, and unless we are aware of what we have at least spent this year, we really have no concept as to...we can't relate them to anything. They are absolutely...

SENATOR MARVEL: I think what the staff has tried to do is to note where there are substantial increase, and if this isn't satisfactory, then we will get you other information. That is all I can tell you. The volume of documents and paperwork that we have gone through is overwhelming, and if we don't have all the information, all I can say is I am sorry and we will get you whatever you like. In this case, for instance, the 75-76 appropriation, and we are talking now about General Fund money, last year was \$926,675 and this year is roughly a \$1,435,151. But your point is well taken. If you want additional information, I will have the staff get it ready and have it reproduced so you can have a copy of it.

PRESIDENT: As your lights come on, I will recognize you because I know that you are all concerned about information from Senator Marvel and other members of the Committee. Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I would just like to clarify one thing. It was my amendment to increase county courts systems budget by \$80,000 to hire the additional clerical personnel and three associate judges but the one to put the money in the budget for the increase in salary for county judges, that was some one else's amendment. I don't want credit for that one.

PRESIDENT: Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Mr. President, I would like to voice the same concern that Senator Dworak just mentioned. These are recent amendments that came out from the Budget Committee and I have absolutely no way right now to compare at least percentage wise of what last year's figure was and what the increase is for this proposed budget year, and unless I have this kind of a comparison, I most certainly wouldn't know how to vote on this particular budget bill. I need that kind of information, too.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel, could I inquire. We probably ought to adopt some uniform procedure here not by rule but how we are going to vote on these. On the 703 thing I think we finally decided that we were going to amend the Committee amendments as we went. Now, as I understand it, the Committee amendments virtually wipe out the bill so what we are really talking about is the Committee amendments and there is a whole series of amendments. Are you prepared to tell the
