SENATOR WARNER: How much less did that cost us?

SENATOR CLARK: He says it will take about 16 to 18 days turnover on a check at that time where now they are down to about 7 days, in turnover time.

SENATOR WARNER: Thank you.

SENATOR CLARK: The only thing is if we don't put this in and complete this system, about the next year, the University is going to ask for the same system and it is just a waste of money the way it is now.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Any further discussion? If not, do you care to close, Senator Clark?

SENATOR CLARK: No closing.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The question is the adoption of the Clark amendment to LB 691. All in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Savage voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Have you all voted? Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The Clark amendment is adopted. Any other amendments?

CLERK: I have many, Mr. President. Senator Burbach wanted to take up his motion, is that right? Mr. President, I move...I have some reports, Mr. President. Senator Bereuter asks to be excused tomorrow, March 16th. Your committee on Revenue to whom was referred LB 919 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File with the request that the Committee amendments not be printed. Signed Senator Carsten. Mr. President, your committee on Education to whom was referred LB 887 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File. Mr. President, Public Works will hold an Executive session underneath the North balcony immediately upon adjournment. Mr. President, I move we adjourn until 9 o'clock. Signed J. W. Burbach.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to adjourn until 9 o'clock tomorrow. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. We are adjourned.
