make those kind of judgements. If the Chief Executive now is concerned about the spending levels, then he can determine what his priorities are. If 454 is not a priority with him, then let him veto it. If it's a priority with 30 of us, then we will over-ride him. If 752 is not a priority with him and it happens to be with me on Special Education then let him veto it. And if he vetoes it I'll guarantee you I'll put the motion right on the desk to over-ride it. That's an Oklahoma promise. I am hopeful that we do not fall into this kind of a vicious thing that will make us look absolutely foolish. I, for one, intend to vote no a thousand times no on this proposal to bring them all back.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: So that we won't waste all afternoon, anybody knows, let's have the previous question.

PRESIDENT: Do I see 5 hands? Yes I do. The question is, shall debate now cease? Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carsten, would you close debate on your motion please?

SENATOR CARSTEN: It's not going to take very long. You know what the subject matter is. I think you know what your mind is, and I say let's vote. Thank you.

CLERK: The motion, Mr. President, is that the Governor be requested to return 454 and 454A.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Have you voted? Please vote. Record, Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: I don't like to do this but I'm going to ask for a call of the House, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Alright. The question is shall the house want a call? Record your vote on that proposition. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The House is under call. Senators, please return to your desks. Senator Koch, we are under call. Would you record your presence please?

CLERK: Senator Duis voting aye. Senator Rumery voting aye. Simpson voting no.

PRESIDENT: Would all Senators return to your desks.

CLERK: Senator Dick Lewis voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Alright.

CLERK: Savage voting no.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carsten moves that the call be raised. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. Call is raised. Report the vote.
