PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Yes. Mr. President, the next amendment is offered by Senator Bereuter. Read amendment. See page 1258, Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Bereuter.

SENATOR BEREUTER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this simply is a procedural correction that is necessary to make it consistent with the previous action we have taken on creating the revolving fund that is known as the Animal Diagnostic and Research Fund. I move for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion on Senator Bereuter's motion? The question is the adoption...Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I will have to admit. I was not listening. I would like to ask Senator Bereuter, again, exactly what he is doing here. I am sorry.

SENATOR BEREUTER: Yes, Senator Kremer,...

SENATOR KREMER: Because I am interested in the fund.

SENATOR BEREUTER: ...we created a revolving fund by previous action and set the limit on it at about \$20,000 so that the money coming in to the new Diagnostic Laboratory which is going on line now can go into that fund and be spent for those purposes and this simply corrects the language in the appropriation bill to recognize the fact we created the fund.

SENATOR KREMER: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is the adoption of Senator Bereuter's amendment. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment offered is offered by Senator Warner. The amendment in one form, I guess it was not inserted in the Journal.

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, it was. 1234 and 1235.

CLERK: Okay, Mr. President, that's what the deal was. This amendment was previously offered and then temporarily withdrawn and is now again offered. It is found on page 1234 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment. What this is, the membership, the amendment is written based upon the passage of LB 579. The reason I offer it on 690 is that included in the original A bill
