SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I will let it go but I did have my light on because I was going to ask was the motion debatable. I did have a comment.

PRESIDENT: Now what motion?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: To suspend the Rules.

PRESIDENT: He moved the previous question and was successful in that so there was no debate on that. So, sir. All right. All we have done is suspend the Rules. Senator Schmit. We have suspended the Rules, Senator Schmit.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 3 nays to suspend the Rules.

PRESIDENT: The Rules are suspended, Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Then, Mr. President, I thought I had it all in one motion but I renew my motion to advance the bill to E & R Final as amended and call for the question.

PRESIDENT: We have been reading those things separately, Senator. All right. Do I see five seconds? The question is, shall debate cease on this matter? Record your vote. This vote is to cease debate on the question to advance. Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 3 nays to cease debate.

PRESIDENT: Debate ceases. There is no close since there was no opening. The question is the advancement of the bill. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 4 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Maresh asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 989 in the Legislative Journal. Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 691 and recommend it be replaced on Select File as amended. Mr. President, your Committee also replaces LB 371 on Select File as amended. Signed Senator Dworak, Chairman. Mr. President, I move we adjourn until 9 o'clock.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. We are adjourned until 9 o'clock in the morning.
