CLERK: Yes, I have some also printed by Senator Marvel on page 1256.

SENATOR MARVEL: I think that the amendment that I refer to now is encompassed in strictly Kearney State College additional increase in the cash fund of \$364,000. This has to do with program 202, instructional services; program 212, institutional support; program 222, academic support and student services. My...are you ready for me?

CLERK: I wanted to verify that that is the amendment that you at one time identified as Number 1. We have....okay.

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir. It starts out on page 11, line 19 strike a million, one-twenty nine.

CLERK: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR MARVEL: So, my first motion that the amendment that you have up there, number one, which I have already identified as affecting Kearney State cash funds, which starts on page 11, line 19, that amendment which is identified as number one be adopted.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Senator Marvel's motion. Voting aye, Mr. clerk. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays Mr. President on the motion to adopt.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Motion is adopted. Senator Marvel.

CLERK: Now Mr. President, there is another amendment offered by Senator Marvel identified as being on page 1256 of the Legislative Journal. This does not bear one of the original numbers. This one starts out on page 13, line 26 strike 3617 and insert 3803.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: Vince, will you read it again?

CLERK: Read amendment.

SENATOR MARVEL: Will you pass over that temporarily? That is the Mental Retardation Amendment.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Senator Marvel is passing over this amendment Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Okay, now Mr. President, I have an amendment offered by Senator Burrows....that may be to the basic bill rather than the amendment. That is all Mr. President, so now we are ready to adopt the Marvel amendment to adopt page 11, line 11 through page 19, line 1.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: Okay, now I am adopting the amendment as amended, right? Vince?
