PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is, shall the bill be advanced? Record your vote. Record. No, no, no, not yet. Now record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. LB 782A.

CLERK: LB 782A introduced by Senator DeCamp and Kime. Read title. Mr. President, there is an amendment offered by Senator Kime. Read amendment. See page 1330, Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kime.

SENATOR KIME: Mr. Chairman and members of this Committee, this amendment, this A bill is not an appropriation bill. The money is already there but this amendment allows it to be spent by the training center to train groups of officers away from the center rather than at the center. The money is already there on hand and it doesn't have to be appropriated. It is the Law Enforcement Improving cash fund that is being used and it has been used in other cases in various times in several years and this is a continuation. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is the adoption of the amendment. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR KIME: I move that the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. LB 806A.

CLERK: LB 806A introduced by the Health and Welfare Committee and signed by Senator Kennedy. Read title.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes, Mr. President, LB 806A appropriates \$25,500 from the general fund and this is to pay for the review of those people that are now in the institutions that have been committed that they will have an opportunity to have a hearing. This is a follow-up of LB 806 and I ask that this 806A be passed off of General File to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, Mr. President, 0 nays.
