SENATOR MAHONEY: Here comes Senator DeCamp. Senator Richard Lewis is the missing person.

CLERK: Oh, then you don't want a roll call, then.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Senator DeCamp.

CLERK: Senator DeCamp voting aye.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Senator Cavanaugh withdraws his request for a roll call vote. Motion the Call be raised. All those in favor, aye.

CLERK: Okay, Senator Syas asked for a record vote. Record vote read. See pages 1334 and 1335, Journal. 25 ayes, 13 nays, remainder not voting.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Cavanaugh, what do you wish to do with the bill?

CLERK: That just did it. That advanced it.

SENATOR MAHONEY: It advanced the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have some material to read into the Journal. Mr. President, Senator Chambers asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 434. In fact, there is a series of amendments, three separate amendment, Mr. President. Mr. President, LR 162 introduced by Senator Cavanaugh calling for an amendment to the federal laws requiring time tables and simplified procedures for review of applications, plans and specifications for Federal highway programs and other public works. The Resolution will be read and laid over. Mr. President, LR 163 introduced by Senator Schmit, DeCamp, Rumery, Maresh and Kennedy calling for a study by the Agriculture Committee on zoning and land use in Nebraska. That will be referred to the Executive Board for review. Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 691 and recommend it be replaced on Select File as amended. Signed Senator Dworak, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 204 and find the same correctly engrossed. Signed Senator Dworak, Chairman. Mr. President, an Attorney General's opinion will be inserted in the Journal addressed to Senator Dworak. See pages 1337 and 1338, Journal. That is all, Mr. President.

SENATOR MAHONEY: All right. Members of the Legislature, we will take up LB 332 and this is a bill we can probably get along with and probably get on its way by lunch time. Senator Schmit, Chairman of Agriculture.

CLERK: LB 332 introduced by the Committee on Agriculture and Environment. Read title. Mr. President, there are Committee amendments by Senator Schmit's Agriculture and Environment Committee.
