SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Senator Anderson.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the specific amendment.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: You heard the motion. Record. Record your vote to adopt his amendment. Have you all voted? Voting aye Vince. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 nays Mr. President.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Mr. President, I move that LB691 be returned to E & R for Engrossing.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: You heard the motion. Record your votes. Record your votes. Voting aye. Bill is advanced.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to advance.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Bill is advanced.

CLERK: I have no more motions on LB691. Now Mr. President, motions on 690.

I move to return LB690 to Select File for specific amendment. Read F. Lewis amendment.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Senator F. Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I ask you to reconsider your action of the other day, and I would ask a Page to come forward and pass this out, on the million dollars that my very good friend Senator John Cavanaugh from Omaha, my choice for the Second Congressional District, inadvertently took out of this bill. Well it is necessary fellows to say something very nice before you start in on an attack. Senator Cavanaugh in all seriousness did remove a million dollars from the campus and central administration. I have a hand-out coming to you showing you the net effect of it and for my concern, and I have a breakdown for you between program 781 and 783 which shows that in actuality that money was taken from the campuses, the University of Nebraska Lincoln, a \$160,000; the University of Nebraska at Omaha, \$97,000; the University of Nebraska Medical Center, \$43,000 under program 781. Under program 783, \$279,000 at UNL; \$94,000 at UNO; \$126,000 at the University of Nebraska Medical College. I think that the hand-out that I gave you is self explanatory, and my purposes for reinserting the money is clear. I would ask you to bring the bill back and adopt my specific amendment.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I rise to support Senator Lewis. I think that the hand-outs that we have had placed before us just now, is explanatory for the purpose and reason to strike Senator Cavanaugh's original intention. I think that
