CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments on 781, but there are other amendments also, so it will get laid over. But, we need to adopt the amendments.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the E & R amendments to LB781.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: 926, and there are amendments.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to 926.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay, they are adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move that LB926 be advanced for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments on 464, as well as other amendments.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB464.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. They are adopted. That is all Senator Dworak.

CLERK: Mr. President your committee reports that they did deliver to the Governor on this day at 6:00 p.m. LB819, signed Barbara Jackson, Enrolling Clerk.

Mr. President, I move to return LB852 to Select File for a specific amendment. Signed, Senator Dickinson.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dickinson.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, it's a little bad to take time at this time of the night, but I need about 5 minutes. You will recall last year that Senator Syas introduced a bill, I'm passing the amendment out to the senators desks right now, that allowed the Omaha School District to buy a farm adjacent to farm land that they have out near the Platte River, without a vote of the people which the law then required. The information given to the Legislature, and I have checked the floor debate and the committee testimony from last year, it indicated that the farm was in the hands of an estate, it was for sale and they could negotiate and would negotiate and buy the land. Well, as the year progressed, I don't know what went wrong, but they were not able to buy this land. About two weeks ago the son of the elderly lady who owns it called me up one night and said that he had received notice of the beginning of condemnation action by the Omaha Public School System. This was not the intent, wasn't the intent of my opinion of Senator Syas or the lobbyists of the Omaha School District that are down here everyday. I asked
