SENATOR SIMPSON: Any further discussion? If not the motion is to adopt. Voting aye. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays and 21 not voting.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Motion is adopted. What shall we do with the bill?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move to advance the bill to E & R Engrossing.

SENATOR SIMPSON: All in favor say aye, opposed say nay. It is advanced. Further motions on the desk?

CLERK: I move to return LB782 to Select File for a specific amendment. Signed, Senator DeCamp. Read amendment.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DE CAMP: This is a technical amendment but it is important. When they wrote the bill they wrote "paired with" when they were talking about reserve officers working with regular officers, instead of "under the direction of". The bill becomes impossible to operate if you have to have "paired with" as some people have told them that paired with would mean one regular with one reserve, and if you have only a sheriff and a deputy and they have five reserves the whole system becomes inoperable. So they want to change the language to "under the direction of regular officers" that is all that it is.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Motion is to return. Is there any further discussion? If not, all in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes on the motion to return.

SENATOR SIMPSON: The bill is returned. Senator DeCamp, what should we do with the amendment?

SENATOR DE CAMP: Adopt it.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Any further discussion? The motion is to adopt. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Amendment is adopted. What shall we do with the bill.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Advance.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Motion is to advance. All in favor say aye, opposed say nay. It is advanced. Further motions?

CLERK: Mr. President, 781, there is a motion, there are two of them. There is a motion offered by Senator Rasmussen
