PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Read the bill. Senator Warner, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR WARNER: Point of information from the Chair. Will I be correct, this will require 30 votes? I believe it's \$1,380,000 over the Governor's budget.

PRESIDENT: Is there an appropriation mentioned in the bill? Thank you for bringing it to my attention. I may be prepared at the time we vote and I may not be prepared.

CLERK: Read title to LB 1006.

(Machine turned off for Final Reading)

PRESIDENT: ... bill and it is in excess of the Governor's budget. First of all it takes 33 votes for the emergency clause. All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1006 pass with the emergency clause. Record your vote. Have you voted? Please vote. Have you voted? Record. Read the vote. Senator Mahoney, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR MAHONEY: I arise for a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Call the roll.

SENATOR MAHONEY: You can't have a Call of the House?

PRESIDENT: We're under Call. We can't have speeches.

CLERK: Senator Anderson--excused.
