PRESIDENT: LB 781A failed to get the Constitutional majority required. Please read LB 782.

CLERK: I have a motion on the desk, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: I move to return LB 782 to Select File for a specific amendment, to strike the enacting clause. Signed, Senator Chambers.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature. I want to ask Senator DeCamp a question if I can. Senator DeCamp, this bill incorporates provisions of a bill that I had in reference to training and goes beyond that to do away with all types of specials, auxiliary and so forth and it creates one force of reserve officers. If I understood something correctly that I saw in a public interview, you felt that the provisions that I was concerned about were wild and unreasonable, so I'm wondering if the inclusion of those provisions in your bill have turned you against the bill? Because if you're not going to support it then I certainly am not.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I guess I don't even understand your question. The bill goes far beyond anything that was originally in 432, or whatever the number was, whatever the bill was.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Are you going to support this bill? Are you going to support 782?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Well of course I'm going to support it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Members of the Legislature, with that clarification from Senator DeCamp, I withdraw my motion.

PRESIDENT: Alright the motion is withdrawn. Senator Kime, did you wish to be heard now in view of the fact it's withdrawn? Please read the bill, Mr. Clerk.

Before you do though we have 19 eleventh and twelfth grade students in the South balcony from Millard High School, Senator Dickinson's district. We appreciate having you students here on Final Reading. There is no debate on Final Reading and that's why there is less activity on the floor. It just amounts to the Clerk reading the bill and then the vote.
