CLERK: 27 ayes to go under Call.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. Please return to your desks and record your presence. Board. We are under Call. Please return to your desks. Senator Lewis voting aye. Oh, you have asked for a roll call vote? Senator Duis, kindly record your presence. Senator Marvel. Senator Kelly. Senator Schmit. Senator Schmit in the building? All right. Commence the roll. Vince, commence the roll, please.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. See page 1607, Journal. 30 ayes, 18 nays, 1 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The bill does become law notwithstanding the Governor's objection. Next.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move that LB 1011 become law notwithstanding the objection of the Governor. Signed Senator Wiltse.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wiltse. Board.

SENATOR WILTSE: Mr. Chairman, I move the bill be advanced as presented. This is a bill that we have all had a good deal of study on. It is vitally important from the angle of Peru itself. It is a good practical investment from our angle in that we are able to buy bonds at a decided discount, and at the same time, relieve some of the situation that we have there in the facilities that we need from an athletic program, a health program and general office use. I move the advancement of the bill.

CLERK: The question is to pass it into law notwithstanding the objection of the Governor.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. We are still under Call. Please stay at your desks. Have you voted? Have you all voted? Please vote. We are under Call, presently. Senator Wiltse.
