SPEAKER: Got a total of 36. You cannot suspend the rules now. We're even adjourned already too. Would you push your button and just give us an indication that you will be here tomorrow, if not we'll have to solicit some others to come back. Twenty-five votes is not sufficient for a suspension of the rules tomorrow. We'll need 30 people, whoever they may be. We'll need that. We're asking you now if you punch a button in the affirmative that you do come tomorrow. Two votes. We have 30 and we have assurance of two other legislators being here. Now that you have indicated that you will be here I certainly hope that you will be here so we can proceed with suspension of the rules tomorrow.
