- AN ACT to amend section 2-3412, Revised Statutes
 Supplement, 1976, relating to the Mebraska
 Poultry and Egg Resources Act; to change
 provisions relating to the director's powers
 to exempt individuals from certain fees; and
 to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 2-3412, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1976, be amended to read as follows:

- 2-3412. (1) The director may exempt from the provisions of section 2-3408 and subsection (2) of section 2-3410 first purchasers whose annual average weekly volume is less than five twenty-five thirty-dozen cases per week whenever the administrative cost of collecting and processing the fees received from such sources exceeds the amount of income derived therefrom.
- (2) Eggs utilized for the production of baby chicks shall be exempt from sections 2-3401 to 2-3416.
- Sec. 2. That original section 2-3412, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1976, is repealed.
