## LEGISLATIVE BILL 311

Approved by the Governor April 2, 1977

AN ACT to amend section 68-1004, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 68-1005, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1976, relating to public welfare; to eliminate age requirements for the purpose of establishing eligibility for assistance to the blind or the disabled; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 68-1004, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

68-1004. In order to quality for assistance to the blind, an individual must, in addition to the requirements set forth in section 68-1002, (4) have been determined to be blind by an examination by a physician skilled in diseases of the eye or by an optometrist. 7 and-(2)-have-attained-the-age-of-sixteen-years.

Sec. 2. That section 68-1005, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1976, be amended to read as follows:

68-1005. In order to qualify for assistance to the disabled, an individual shall, in addition to the requirements set forth in section 68-1002, (4) be disabled so as to be substantially precluded from engaging in useful work by reason of medically determinable physical or mental impairment which can be expected to have a duration of not less than one hundred eighty days from the date of onset. 7--and--(2)--have attained-the-age-of-eighteen-years:

Sec. 3. That original section 68-1004, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 68-1005, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1976, are repealed.
