## LEGISLATIVE BILL 830

Approved by the Governor April 20, 1978

Introduced by Savage, 10

AN ACT to amend section 18-1724, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to cities and villages; to change provisions relating to discrimination ordinances as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 18-1724, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

18-1724. Notwithstanding any other law or laws heretofore enacted, all cities and villages in this state shall have the power by ordinance to define, regulate, suppress and prevent discrimination on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, ancestry, sex, <u>marital status</u>, or national origin, <u>age</u>, or <u>disability</u> in employment, <u>and-in</u> public accommodation, <u>and housing</u>, and may provide for the enforcement of such ordinances by providing appropriate penalties for the violation thereof. It <u>shall not be an unlawful employment practice to refuse</u> <u>employment based on a policy of not employing both</u> <u>husband and wife if such policy is equally applied to</u>

Sec. 2. That original section 18-1724, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
