SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President and members, it is never, no matter how well prepared a person can be, it is never easy to accept the loss of a loved one such as Senator Haberman has had to accept the last week or two, but Senator Haberman was here in this Chamber performing his duties the day before his mother's funeral, representing his people even though it had to be hurting him very deeply inside.
