Mr. President, I have a Reference Report from the Reference Committee referring LBs 244 through 302, as well as LRs 10, 11 and 12, and re-referring LB 171 from Revenue to the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee.

Mr. President, your Committee on Constitutional Revision and Recreation gives notice of hearing for January 27 and 28, signed by Senator Labeledz as Chair.
