SENATOR CLARK: The bill is not advanced. We will now go to LB 116.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 116 was a bill introduced by Senator Barrett. (Read.) The bill was read on January 11, referred to Miscellaneous Subjects. The bill was advanced to General File, Mr. President. There are no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Barrett, on the bill.

SENATOR BARRETT: I'm tired, Mr. President. 116E, very, very simple bill, an exercise we go through every few years authorizing the Adjutant General of the State of Nebraska to convey easements to the Armory in Lexington for the installation construction of sewer pipes and electric transmission lines. We did this for the City of York recently. We have done it for the City of Kearney. This is the only way it can be done. I would simply move the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any discussion on the bill? If not, all those in favor of advancing the bill will vote aye, opposed will vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is advanced. We go to LB 52, Senator Marsh.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 52 was a bill introduced by Senator Marsh. (Read.) The bill was read on January 6. It was referred to Urban Affairs, was advanced to General File, Mr. President. I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Marsh, on the bill.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. The purpose of LB 52 is to amend current statutory provisions relating to the procedures for appeals by the taxpayers and claimants filing claims against a primary class city which is the City of Lincoln and from administrative or judicial orders or decisions of the Lincoln City Council or any officer or department or board of the city of the primary class. This applies to Lincoln. Currently the appeal
