CLERK: Mr. President, if I may right before that, your committee on Banking gives notice of hearing for February 15, 22 and 28. Public Works gives notice of cancellation of a hearing. Public Works reports LB 49 advanced to General File with committee amendments attached. LB 466 offered by the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee advances the bill to General File with committee amendments attached. The Ag and Environment Committee will hold an Executive Session tomorrow at eight o'clock in Room 1114. Your committee on Banking reports LB 95 as indefinitely postponed and LB 136 as indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator DeCamp as Chair. Mr. President, with respect to LB 274, Senator Hoagland did have an amendment. I understand, Senator, you wish to withdraw that.

PRESIDENT: Senator, we would ask that you formally request withdrawal. We didn't have you on the speaker system yet.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: My amendment to LB 274 has been printed, Mr. President. I formally request that it be withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: Without objection, so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have....

PRESIDENT: Do you want to move then LB 274? Senator Rod Johnson, did we adopt the E & R amendments to LB 274?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: No, sir.

PRESIDENT: Are there some?

CLERK: Yes, there are.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move that we adopt the E & R amendments to LB 274.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor say aye, opposed no. The motion carried.
