SENATOR HIGGINS: Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Higgins.

SENATOR HIGGINS: I would request a roll call vote please.

PRESIDENT: Very well, Senator. The House is under Call. Will all members please return to the Chamber, take their seats, and record your presence. The House is under Call. Will all members please report to the Chamber, take their seats, and record your presence. Senator Abboud, Senator Barrett, Senator Haberman. We are informed that three members are excused. At the present time we have...is Senator Barrett in the whereabouts. The House is under Call. All members take their seats and record their presence. The House is under Call. Will all members record their presence. Senator Schmit is here. Senator Labedz is here. Senator Warner, is Senator Warner in the distance of this hearing mechanism? The House is under Call. Senator Higgins, would you care to proceed without Senator Warner calling in. We can't seem to locate him.

SENATOR HIGGINS: We have 46 members present, and how many excused? Two. I would just like a roll call vote then and we will proceed.

PRESIDENT: Proceed with the roll call vote, Mr. Clerk, and quiet in the Chamber while the roll call vote is being taken please. A request to read the amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Higgins has moved: (Reread Higgins amendment as found on page 447, Legislative Journal.) (Roll call vote taken. See page 447, Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: 19 ayes, 19 nays. The Clerk has recorded a tie, correct? Mr. Clerk. The motion fails. A tie has resulted on the vote. There is nothing further on the bill. Senator Landis, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR LANDIS: I just wish to move the bill to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: The question is on the moving of the bill to E & R. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Senator Doyle.
