LB 50, 138, 139

PRESIDENT: The question is on that motion to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is to advance LB 50 from Select File to Enrollment and Review for engrossment. A record vote has been requested. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 460 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The bill is advanced. Does the Clerk have announcements? The Chair recognizes Speaker Nichol.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, we have several bills on Select File that do not have amendments and I suggest that we take those and run those so we can facilitate at least those bills and this will shorten up Select File and get those moved on, so I suggest we do that. We should be able to do that in a very few minutes.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, on LB 138 I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Rod Johnson. Senator Beutler is the Chairman of the Judiciary Committee. Do you care to move the bill?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I would move the advancement of LB 138.

PRESIDENT: Motion is made to advance LB 138. All those in favor say aye, opposed vote no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 139.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I would move the advancement of LB 139.

PRESIDENT: Are there amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, no amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LP 139 off Select File. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 88.
