LB 401, 413

PRESIDENT: On the question, all those in favor say aye, opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 401.

CLERK: I have nothing on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move that we advance LB 401 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor say aye, opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 413.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no E & R amendments. I do have an amendment pending by Senator Fenger that I understand Senator Warner will handle.

PRESIDENT: Is the amendment available or are you going to read it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: It is found on page 480 of the Legislative Journal, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner. Order in the Chamber, please. (Gavel.) Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move adoption of the amendment. This was the bill that would extend for one year the four agencies that were scheduled for sunset as of June 30, or July 1 rather, of 1983. It extends them for one year which would permit those four bills which have been introduced to be carried over to the even numbered session, the 1984 session, to be handled and that is all the amendment does plus it adds one other amendment to the existing law covering the sunset which required that each agency be handled in a separate bill and this amendment would permit these four agencies to be handled in this one bill to be extended one year. That is all it does.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? If not, those in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye, opposed vote no, machine vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to adopt Senator Fenger's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The Fenger amendment is adopted. The motion carried. Now to move the bill.
