

SPEAKER NICHOL: All in favor of adopting the E & R amendment please say aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Nothing further on the bill. The question is, shall LB 44 be advanced from Select File. All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 44 is advanced. Senator Cullan has asked that LB 126 be passed over for today only and it will come up the next time we are on Select File. We will move on to LB 249. Senator Barrett has asked that we pass over LB 249 because of the same situation, amendments being worked out. LB 421.

CLERK: I have nothing on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall LB 421 be advanced from Select File. All those in favor signify by voting aye, saying aye, opposed nay. The bill is advanced. LB 107.

CLERK: I have E & R amendments to LB 107, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Kilgarin.

SENATOR KILGARIN: I move we adopt the E & R amendments to LB 107.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall LB 107 be advanced. Senator Kahle, did you wish to speak on it? Excuse me.

SENATOR KAHLE: Well I would like to know a little bit more about this before we vote on it, if Senator Johnson would explain. . . .

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vard Johnson, would you respond to questions?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Senator Kahle, this legislative bill does this. Let me start at the beginning with it. All of us as homeowners and as heads of families, assuming we are the heads of families, have a statutory exemption from creditor process of \$6,500 in value in our house or our farmstead. And what that means is this, Senator Kahle, if a creditor brings a lawsuit against us, takes a judgment against us and then levies execution on our property, that creditor can take some of our property but the creditor can
