CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on pages 848 and 849 of the Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 28 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Any further amendments on LB 199?

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have to the bill is offered by Senator Morehead. It is found on page 785 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Morehead.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Mr. President and colleagues, I offer this amendment for several reasons. First of all, I am being inundated with mail from my district in regards to duplicate permits. I have a feeling that not very many people in this body are campers or do camp and it is my understanding that members of the Commission who...
