

by unemployment compensation coverage. Since the issue seemed to relate with the substance of LB 319, it was thought to be germane and reasonable to include their amendments with this bill and would provide for an exemption from unemployment compensation coverage for certain types of employees, primarily focusing on the Donnelley situation so that they could have what they had for 30 years and not be under the coverage of unemployment compensation. Those are the amendments the committee has adopted.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the committee amendments? There are amendments to the committee amendments.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Fowler had a motion to strike Section 2 of the committee amendments. Senator Fowler is excused. I do, however, have an amendment from Senator Wesely to the committee amendments. (Read Wesely amendment as found on page 853, Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. President and members of the Legislature, in discussing the concerns of the committee amendments with those representatives of organized labor, it was felt that it would be beneficial to tighten up the language in the amendment. This change, this amendment to the committee amendments would do exactly that by striking the language "direct marketing or" and striking the language "directories or other". We are able to have a language that would say "service performed by an individual for a business engaged in compilation of marketing data bases" and that is it, period. Essentially we don't see this exemption applying to any other circumstance than one that the Donnelley Corporation is now involved in. Of course, if other firms would be involved in developing marketing data bases, they would be covered, but as far as we know, Donnelley is the only one involved. We are tightening up the amendment so it only applies to a particular circumstance where there is a serious problem right now and we feel that this will take care of some of the concerns that have been expressed in opposition to the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Are there further discussions on the Wesely amendment? The question is, shall the Wesely amendment to the committee...the amendment to the amendment be adopted. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.
