CLERK: Mr. President, if I may right before that, I have an announcement from Senator Morehead regarding cancellation of the trip to the Beatrice State Developmental Center for Thursday, March 24. Apparently the trip will be rescheduled later this year.

Mr. President, new resolution by Senators Chronister and Hefner. (Read LR 45 as found on page 949 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Carsten and the Revenue Committee would report LB 224 advanced to General File with committee amendments attached. Senator Schmit and the Public Works Committee would report LB 234 advanced to General File with committee amendments attached. (See pages 949 through 950 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, with regards to LB 252, it was a bill introduced by Senator Schmit, DeCamp, Pappas, Kahle, Sleek, Hefner and Rod Johnson. (Read title.) The bill was first read on January 14, referred to the Banking Committee for hearing. The bill was advanced to General File, Mr. President. There are Banking Committee amendments pending.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, you will have a lot more explanation on the bill from Senator Schmit and Senator Rod Johnson. The committee amendments put an E clause on. They clear up some technical language. They change the word "all" to the word "substantially", and with that the committee then advanced the bill to the floor eight to zero, declaring a public policy to not require a finding of public convenience because these commodity or credit coop associations have already demonstrated by their very existence that they meet the public convenience test. With that, I would move to adopt the committee amendments, and I know Senator Johnson has some amendments, and I think Senator Schmit does.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted.
