LB 302A, 573A

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 302A (read title).

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Cal Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this is a bill that goes along with the special fuels tax that does have some responsibility of financing of it. As you know, 302 has not moved along. We are still holding it for one amendment, but after that amendment is adopted, it will be in good shape but this does need to go along with it to finance this operation. I would move for the advancement.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any other discussion on the bill? If not, those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Thank you for voting promptly. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the A bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 302 A advances. LB 573A. Okay, we will move on to LB 579A. Okay, Senator Haberman is not here. Senator Peterson, can you take those two? Senator Richard Peterson.

SENATOR P. PETERSON: Speaker Nichol and members, which one are we on?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Let's go to LB 573A, Senator Peterson.

SENATOR R. PETERSON: Okay, I just became aware that Senator Haberman wasn't here. This, Section 1, there is hereby appropriated \$2,250 for the brucellosis control cash fund for the period of July 1, 1983, to June 30th, 1984, and \$2,250 from the brucellosis control cash fund for the period July 1, 1984 to 1985, June 30, to the Department of Agriculture. So there is really no expenses really pertinent to and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section. I ask for unanimous vote on this.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of LB 573A. All those in favor say aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the A bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 573A is advanced. Senator Richard Peterson, can you handle LB 579A also?
