SENATOR R. PETERSON: I will try. This just transfers dollars from the Management Service Expense Revolving Fund over for the Department of Agriculture and it just aids in carrying out the provisions of LB 579 for salaries and per diems. I would just ask for your vote, advance vote in adopting these funds and advancing the bill, the A bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall LB 579A advance. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the A bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. Do you have something, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Education whose Chairman is Senator Vickers to whom was referred LB 227 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File; 130, General File with amendments; 289 indefinitely postponed; 328 indefinitely postponed; and 387 indefinitely postponed. All signed by Senator Vickers.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We will move on to General File and we will pick up LB 363 where we left off a few days ago.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 363, of course, was a bill offered by Senators Newell and Morehead. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 17th, referred to the Revenue Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments at this time to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Morehead, the other day you had explained the bill somewhat. We will ask you to sort of recap what you told us the other day and we will go on from there. There are no committee amendments, and as far as I know no amendments, but before you start may I please introduce one more guest.
