be a part of this Class 3 and stand all of the costs. That is what caused Class 6 legislation on the books in this state and I am here to say to you that that is probably the biggest mistake that this Legislature ever made was to put that Class 6 legislation on the books.

I think most of us understand what we are attempting to do that we are simply attempting to buy some time on this very sensitive issue and that I have indicated that the committee will seriously study the issue over the interim and try to take into consideration the points of view of all parties involved and with that I would just, and also I have also agreed that we will look at language changes over on Select File to take care of some of the problems that other interested parties have with it. With that, I would just move the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the adoption of the committee amendments. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted. May I remind you that Senator Kahle has a guest from Kearney under the south balcony, Norma Johnson, wife of Reverend Robert Johnson. Would you please welcome her to the Legislature. Thank you. Mr. Clerk, do you have something to read in?
