PRESIDENT: The question is to indefinitely postpone LB 169. All those in favor will vote aye, opposed vote nay. And silence in the Chamber please, the Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1088, Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, and 28 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The majority having voted in the negative the motion fails. Anything on the desk, Mr. Clerk? Oh, we still have LB 169 with us and we have an amendment to it.

CLERK: If I may right before I get to that, Senator Vickers would like to print amendments to LB 118.

Senator DeCamp and Haberman would move that 533 be placed on General File notwithstanding the action of the committee.

LB 204A, 302A, 573A, 579A all reported to Select File.
