SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Mr. President, your committee now escorting the Governor of the great State of Nebraska, the Honorable Bob Kerrey.

PRESIDENT: Please escort the Governor to the front of the Chamber. It is my honor to present to you the Governor of the State of Nebraska.

GOVERNOR: (Contents of Governor Kerrey's address can be found on pages 1141 thru 1151 of the Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Will the escort committee escort the Governor to the rear of the Chamber. Thank you very much, Governor Kerrey. Legislature will regroup for Final Reading. Chair would ask the membership to come back to the Chamber and take your seats and be in a position to begin the Final Reading agenda for the day. Members, please take your seats. We will go on to Final Reading. Under the rules all members are to be in their seats during Final Reading and unauthorized personnel are to be off the legislative floor. So let us assume those positions and proceed with Final Reading. Members will please take their seats. We are attempting to reach the point of Final Reading of a number of bills. Members please take your seats, and we will proceed to Final Reading. Order in the Chamber. Proceed to Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, LB 277. All members are to be in their seats. Final Reading is in order.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Final Reading of LB 277.)

PRESIDENT: We're voting on LB 277. All those in favor of the bill vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on LB 277. All those ... Have you all recorded your vote? Asking for you to register your vote on LB 277. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote found on pages 1109 and 1110 of the Journal.) 40 ayes, 1 nay, 6 excused not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority voting in the affirmative, LB 277 is declared passed on Final Reading. Legislative Bill 438.

CLERK: (Final Reading of LB 438.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote.
