LB 225, 225A, 93, 180, 366

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Doyle. Did you wish to close on your bill, Senator Hefner? You have about two minutes left.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I will just very briefly say that if the medical profession and attorneys want continuing education well I think that maybe we should introduce a bill and go from there. This bill was brought to me by the funeral directors. It is only sixteen hours and I think if they want to improve the members of their profession well we should go ahead and allow that. Therefore, I would urge you to support the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall LB 225 advance. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote if you care to. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill advances. LB 450. Oh, excuse me, we have a 225A. Senator Hefner, a little. . . .

CLERK: Mr. President, 225A offered by Senator Hefner. (Read title.)

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I move the advancement of LB 225A. This is a small appropriation bill. I believe it is less than a thousand dollars.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely, did you have your light on for a purpose? Okay, Senator Haberman, you have your light on. The question is, shall LB 225A advance. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote so we can go on. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the A bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 225A advances. LB 415.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may right before we get to 415, Senator Rod Johnson would like to print amendments to LB 366. Public Health and Welfare reports LB 93 indefinitely postponed. That is signed by Senator Fenger. Government reports LB 180 advanced to General File with committee amendments attached. (See pages 1158-1160 of the Legislative Journal.)
