SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 282A with the emergency clause passed.
LB 299.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 299 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? It is a good day. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 1192 and 1193, Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, 3 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 299 passes. LB 378.

CLERK: (Read LB 378 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 1193 and 1194, Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 378 passes. We will move on to Select File and you will notice that we are going to stay on Select File until three o'clock, and if we are not through with the Select File including priority bills and the other bills, we will jump to #10 which is the appropriation bill for the Governor, LB 602, at three o'clock, and continue on from that point. Okay, with that we will move on to LB 35.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may, right before that, Enrollment and Review reports LB 96 to Select File; 199A to Select File; 235A to Select File; 309 to Select File, all signed by Senator Rod Johnson.

Mr. President, LB 35 does have E & R amendments pending.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Rod Johnson, are you here? Senator Wagner, would you move the E & R amendments for us please.

SENATOR WAGNER: Mr. Speaker, members, I move the E & R amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All those in favor please say aye, opposed nay. They are adopted.
