SENATOR BEUTLER: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports 461 to Select File, 599, 424, 469, 225, 225A, 415, 353, 511, 227, 503 and 587 and 397 all to Select File.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Are we ready to proceed with LB 2..120 Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 120 offered by Senator Warner, (Read title). The bill was read on January 11th, referred to the Public Works Committee. The bill was advanced to General File, Mr. President. There are committee amendments pending.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Is Senator Schmit on the floor? Senator Lamb, are you prepared to take up the committee amendments? Please do.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members, LB 120 is a bill which deals with changing the provisions for signs along highways and the committee amendments authorize the posting of logo signs on interstate and qualifying federal aid primary highways. Such signs provide travellers with information regarding food, fuel, lodging, camping and related services. The amendments further provide for signs erected between April 16, 1982 and the effective date of the act which do not conform to the federal highway beautification act, shall be, there will be compensation for removing those signs. I would ask that the committee amendments be adopted.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Is there any further discussion on the committee amendments? If not, we have an amendment to the committee amendments. Senator Warner you have an amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment. It purely is a technical amendment on the second page of the committee amendment. On line 20 it says, "For the purpose of this section" and it should read "subsection" according to the bill drafters it should be "subsection". That is all my amendment does to the committee amendment. I move its adoption. On the second page of the committee amendment.
