

are no further amendments to the bill. Senator Warner, did you wish to further address the bill? Senator DeCamp is the only light on. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, just to say that on the subject of sign legislation we have had in the law for many years the logo bill and we were never able to get it successfully implemented. The state government, various departments simply refused to implement it under one theory or another from year to year. This issue was hotly contested in the Public Works Committee this year as to what we could do and we do understand that this correction has to be made which 120 makes, which is a very simple matter to save the federal funds. At the same time I think about 15 of the people that signed on the sign bill, the major sign bill from Senator Lamb, Schmit, Hefner, myself a variety of senators want to make sure that in conjunction with LB 120 we address the overall issue of some legitimate system for Nebraska businesses to advertise along the roadways of this state to attract the tourist, the tourist dollar and to give them a chance to exist by telling the passing and travelling public that they exist. So I am going to vote for the bill at this time. But, I would hope that either in LB 120 or the other bill that deals with signs we do something fair that still comports with federal law and rules and regs to provide some outdoor advertising for Nebraska businesses.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Warner, would you care to close on the bill? Senator Warner has waived closing. So we are now voting on the advancement of LB 120. Those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Is there anyone who wishes to vote on the bill? Is there anyone who wishes to vote on the bill? Mr. Clerk, record the vote.
