PRESIDENT: We have now reached our full complement of working Senators. There are 8 excused.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Next we take up consideration of LB 96. Mr. Speaker. The Call of the House is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no amendments to LB 96.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move that we advance LB 96 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. LB 235A.

CLERK: I have nothing on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Rod Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move that we advance LB 235A to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 309.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing on the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I would move that we advance LB 309 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Yes, Senator Newell.
