SENATOR NEWELL: I may be looking at the wrong sheet but I don't see 309 on my sheet.

PRESIDENT: I have it on my agenda, March 30, 1983.

SENATOR NEWELL: I have the March 30th agenda and I don't see...

PRESIDENT: I have 235, 309, and 506. Is there some confusion, Mr. Clerk? Okay. LB 506. Is anyone authorized to handle Senator Haberman's bill, LB 506. There is an amendment on the bill, his own amendment. Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: I believe Senator Haberman is here and will be back in a few minutes so if we could pass over it momentarily perhaps...

PRESIDENT: Without objection we will pass over LB 506 temporarily. There has been a request on the part of the introducer to pass over LB 64. Without objection, so ordered. LB 213.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have E & R amendments to LB 213.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move we adopt the E & R amendments to LB 213.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move that we advance LB 213 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: A machine vote has been requested on the motion to advance LB 213. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is to advance LB 213. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. A machine vote has been requested. All those wishing to vote on this bill should vote within the next 30 seconds, the Board open 30 seconds. The motion is to advance LB 213. 25 votes required. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.
