CLERK: Mr. President, I now have an amendment from Senator Newell and it is found on page 1243 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: What page?

CLERK: 1243.

PRESIDENT: Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, this amendment is really a clarification of the license and it designates who the license applicant must pay the fee, it will be to either the city, village, or a clerk, village clerk or city clerk, or whatever, and that is all the amendment does.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on this amendment? Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I rise to support this amendment. After going through the bill, we realized that we need to add this amendment to the bill and so I would urge your support for the Newell amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, I have a little problem since this is not in my book yet and it should be since it is yesterday's Journal. So it is a little difficult for me to know what it reads. Is it a long amendment, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, Senator, it is not.

SENATOR MARSH: Could you read it then please since I do not have it.

CLERK: On page 7, line 7, after the "B" insert "and K"

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the amendment? If not, all those in favor of the amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the amendment offered by Senator Newell to LB 133. Please record your vote. We will hold the Board open for 30 seconds to record this vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carried. The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk.
