PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move we advance LB 440.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 461.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 461.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move that we adopt the E & R amendments to LB 461.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion, all those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Rod Johnson and Senator Beutler would move to amend the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, all we are attempting to do here is strike Section 10 of this bill, which is my bill. LB 447 which is a priority bill out of the Judiciary Committee basically rewrites the Nebraska Civil Procedure law and deals with this section. It is with the service of processing so Senator Beutler has some concerns, as did I, and so simply to alleviate that problem we are striking Section 10.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? If not, the question is the adoption of the Johnson amendment to LB 461. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on the amendment to LB 461. Please record your vote. Please record your vote on the Johnson amendment to LB 461. May we have help with one more vote to adopt. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.
