SENATOR WARNER: But you can see, the agencies, if you will look at the fiscal note, it shows the agencies that are affected, and as I indicated, there are a number of others that are of a similar nature which we do not charge the 15%.

SENATOR NEWELL: So, basically, what we are trying to do here is create uniformity.

SENATOR WARNER: Equity.

SENATOR NEWELL: Thank you, Senator Warner. I think I understand now. I am not sure what I think about the bill but I understand.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? If not, the motion is to advance LB 469. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 225.

CLERK: I have E & R amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move that we adopt the E & R amendments to 225.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move we advance LB 225.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Excuse me, Senator Beutler, excuse me.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I would like to file a quick amendment to LB 225 if I could.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend the bill. (Read Beutler amendment found on page 1271, Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I had an amendment filed to the bill which I withdrew and Senator Hefner and I conferred on an alternative to that which I believe Senator Hefner has agreed upon is correct.
